Happy New Year!! Happy New "Church" Year that is. As we enter the Advent Season we also enter a new liturgical year that differs from our calendar year. Our church year or the church liturgical calendar starts with Advent. So Happy New Year!

As we begin the Advent season, it starts a season of anticipation, hope and longing for the Savior's coming, at Christmas and his glorious second coming. It is a time of prayer, penance and preparation, like a "little" lent. A time to hold off on Christmas so as to deepen our thanks and anticipation of our Savior's coming to bring light into darkness. To help in this preparation, in addition to the regular confession times, the following confessions times will also be available during Advent:

Dec. 6th, Thurs. 7-8pm (T) Dec. 11th, Tues. 7-8pm (N) Dec. 16th, Sun. 7-8pm (T) Dec. 20, Thurs. 7-8pm (N)

Receive God's mercy and the sacramental grace to help grow in holiness and relationship with our Lord this Advent Season in anticipation of Christmas.

Please note that **Immaculate Conception, a holy day of obligation,** is coming up. For this holy day, mass will be offered on Friday, December 7th at 5:00pm at St. Francis and 7:00pm at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and on Saturday, December 8th at 8:30am at St. Francis.

Or under church guidelines one may also fulfill the Immaculate Conception holy day obligation by attending one of the vigil masses for the Second Sunday of Advent on Saturday, December 8th at 5:00pm at St. Francis or 7:00pm at OLMC. But if one goes to one of these vigil masses intending it for the Immaculate Conception holy day, then they would need to go to mass on Sunday as well. Can be confusing! But ultimately one needs to go to mass **twice** this weekend!! Once for the Immaculate Conception and once for the regular Sunday holy day. What's the harm in that!!
