Reports:

Rosary Sodality – no report

Liturgy Committee – Roxanne McNally – Roxanne, Kathy Sauser & Susie Ames organized the back vestibule of the church. They plan on re-doing the leaflet bin with plexi-glass so the leaflets can be easily viewed. There is a church library drop box in the vestibule if anyone needs to use it. If you post something on the bulletin board, please remove it once it is expired. If you notice something on the board that is expired please feel free to remove it. The Liturgy Committee is working on better way to post sign-up sheets, etc. in the back of the church that will not damage the newly refinished back doors. Tape and tacks are not good for the wooden doors.

Knights of Columbus – Dale Kallhoff – Any Catholic male over the age of 18 can become a Knight. The Knights meet once a month on the first Tuesday of the month at 8 p.m. If you are interested please talk to any Knight or Father. The Seminarian breakfast is this Sunday. The Ham & Beef dinner is April 7th from 5-8 p.m. in the church basement. (There is also a penance service that night in the church at 7:00 p.m.)

CCD – Amy Baker – All teacher positions have been filled for the grade school CCD. Thank you volunteers!! There will be confirmation in October. So, Angie Belitz, Becky Kerkman & Beth Ramold are looking for some help with that age group and senior high.

Pope John School – Father Pat – PJ is hiring a new director of advancement, Father is part of the interview committee.

Maintenance – Doug Haselhorst – Doug checked into the elevator, and whether it meets ADA standards. Although, it may not be to current code, it does fit most wheelchairs (not scooters). It is grandfathered in at this point in time. If we make any changes, it would have to be to current code. This would require a major renovation, and major capital outlay.

Pastor's Report – Father Pat

Fundraiser Account – St. Francis has a separate checking account for this fundraising account. Father gave an update on the deposits/checks on this account covering about the last year. The main source of funds and expenses for this account is the Super Bowl brunch.

Mass Times/Pastoral Planning – Father seeks input on best mass time for our parish, whether Sat. evening or Sunday morning, when at some point in the future (no immediate change) one weekend mass per eight parishes.

Archbishop's Annual Appeal – Way to go St. Francis! We met both goals, both financial & participation. We are one of 24 churches in the Archdiocese to do so. Thank you to everyone who participated!

ArchOmaha Unite – ArchOmaha Unite is Saturday, June 8th in Omaha at CHI Health Center Arena. There are a variety of activities for different ages. You can register on-line at unite.archomaha.org, or by contacting the parish office. 8 parishioners have signed up thus far. We are looking for approximately 45. Father has chartered a 56 passenger bus for both St. Francis and OLMC to leave the St. Francis parking lot that day and returning that day.

Formed.org – Formed is a Catholic website full of information and inspiration. It could be an excellent resource for our CCD instructors. The cost to subscribe is \$875.00 for both St. Francis & OLMC., for access. Will discuss further next meeting.

New Business:

ADA Bathrooms

Choice #1 - Two ADA bathrooms, one men's and one women's. Widen doorways, add changing tables, light sensors, higher toilets & grab bars. Cost \$8,130.00.

Choice #2 - Make the men's a unisex bathroom, handicap accessible (as above). Existing women's, stays the same except change out toilets to right height, add a changing table, floor length mirror, and add light sensors. Cost \$7,430.

The Parish Council voted to go with Choice #1, due to the small difference in price, and the superior benefits to having two fully useable facilities.

Mowing – Craig Heckert submitted a bid of \$70.00 per mowing (the same as last year), and \$225.00 per fertilizer application, with three applications needed for a total of \$675.00 for the season. We have accepted Craig's bid. Last year a generous donor paid for the entire season of fertilizer applications.

Security Watch as Presented by Brad Higgins – Del Ames will set up a meeting in late August or first of September with all ushers for a presentation/training from Brad Higgins on church security. This is a free service offered by Brad. Thank You, Brad!

Spring Cleanup – Del Ames, Larry Reuss, Doug Haselhorst and Father Pat will perform a walk through on April 6th @ 9:30 a.m. to make a list of projects that need to be addressed during the Spring Clean-up.
